### Install New PAF File for FeatureCAM

FeatureCAM no longer uses the security codes that you type in. Please read these instructions carefully.

Starting with version 2008, FeatureCAM now uses the Delcam PAF security mechanism. Under this system you will receive a new file with the extension **.paf** each time you renew your maintenance. For customers who are familiar with the old FeatureCAM security system, you will no longer have to enter product codes with each new release.

The license file is known as the PAF. Anytime there is a change in your license (Examples: renew your maintenance, add new software, change dongles) you will receive a new PAF file by E-Mail. Together with your dongle your PAF will enable you to run your Delcam products. This file needs to be placed in the proper folder on each computer using Delcam software. For a new software installation, you may need to create the folder first. Your PAF should not be edited or changed in any way or your software may not run.

The attached file is a PAF security file with a name something like this: DEL26-02P.paf

Place the PAF file in only **ONE** of the following locations:

- C:\Program Files\Common Files\Delcam\

Or..

- C:\dcam\config\pass\

If the folder does not already exist, you must create it. We recommend placing the PAF file into the C:\Program Files\Common Files\Delcam\ directory.

Note that you should have only one .PAF file installed. If there is another file with the .PAF extension in either of these directories you should rename it to something like DEL26-02P.old
